 - Please REVIEW both sides of this material with your son and sign on the reverse side.
- 2) Boy Scout Application**
 - Please READ the reverse side, then complete and sign the application.
- 3) Boy Scout Troop 139 New Member Application**
 - Please complete BOTH SIDES (parent information on reverse side)
 - Please include a check payable to Troop 139 for the amount shown on the application.
- 4) Agreement to Release and Hold Harmless and Indemnify**
 - Please complete BOTH SIDES (medical history on reverse side)
- 5) Troop Resource Survey**
 - Please complete BOTH SIDES
- 6) Other Joining Requirements**
 - Your son must complete all of the Joining Requirements and sign the promise.

What to do...

- Please give completed forms and your payment for membership dues (*see #3 above*) to the **Troop Scoutmaster**, who will conduct a "Scoutmaster Conference" with your son to verify completion of all the Joining Requirements.
- After conclusion of the Scoutmaster Conference, your new Scout will receive a *Boy Scout Handbook*. All of the Troop-supplied uniform parts and a 3-ring binder containing other important information will be provided the week after the Scoutmaster Conference.
