

Eagle Scout Requirements



Reaching Eagle Scout rank has some special requirements. After you reach Life rank:

- 1) You must complete a pre-approved **Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project**. The instructions and forms will be made available to you when you reach Life rank, or you can download them from the Troop web site.
- 2) You must file an **Eagle Scout Rank Application**. The application form will be made available to you when you reach Life rank, or you can download it from the Troop web site. *Ask the Troop Advancement Chairperson to provide you with an Eagle Application Assistance report after you reach Life rank.*
- 3) You must submit copies of your merit badge "**Blue Cards**" as proof that you earned the required 21 merit badges. *Be sure that you keep your "Blue Cards" organized in the holders provided.*
- 4) You must provide **Recommendation Letters**.
- 5) You must provide a written **Statement of Your Ambitions and Life Purpose**.
- 6) You must be **active** in the Troop for 6 months just like you did for Life rank.
- 7) You must hold a qualifying **Leadership Position(s)** in the Troop for 6 months just like you did for Life rank.
- 8) Your **Scoutmaster Conference** will be with the Troop Scoutmaster and also any Assistant Scoutmasters that may be available.
- 9) Your **Board of Review** will be conducted by the Los Angeles Area Council instead of by your Troop.
